<u>Deuteronomy 6:4</u> Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD: 5 And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.

<u>Matthew 22:37</u> Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. 38 This is the first and great commandment. 39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. (Lev. 19:18) 40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets. (Mark 12:29-3, Luke 10:27)

<u>1 Samuel 13:14</u> But now thy kingdom shall not continue: the <u>LORD hath sought him a man after his own heart</u>, and the LORD hath commanded him to be captain over his people, because thou hast not kept that which the LORD commanded thee.

<u>Acts 13:22</u> And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, <u>a man after mine own heart</u>, which shall fulfil all my will.

<u>Jeremiah 29:11</u> For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.12 Then shall ye call upon me, and ye shall go and pray unto me, and I will hearken unto you. 13 And <u>ye shall seek me</u>, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart.

<u>1 Chronicles 28:9</u> And thou, Solomon my son, know thou the God of thy father, and serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind: for the LORD searcheth all hearts, and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts: if thou seek him, he will be found of thee; but if thou forsake him, he will cast thee off for ever.

Isaiah 55:6 Seek ye the LORD while he may be found, call ye upon him while he is near:

<u>Genesis 22:11</u> And the angel of the LORD called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, Here am I. 12 And he said, Lay not thine hand upon the lad, neither do thou any thing unto him: for now I know that thou fearest God, seeing thou hast not withheld thy son, thine only son from me.

<u>Luke 22:42</u> Saying, Father, if thou be willing, remove this cup from me: nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done. (Matt 26:36-42, Mark 14:32-42)

<u>Joshua 22:5</u> But take diligent heed to do the commandment and the law, which Moses the servant of the LORD charged you, to <u>love the LORD your God</u>, and to walk in all his ways, and to keep his commandments, and to cleave unto him, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul.

<u>Colossians 3:23</u> And whatsoever ye do, <u>do it heartily</u>, as to the Lord, and not unto men; 24 Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ.

Ecclesiastes 9:10 Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might; for there is no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave, whither thou goest.

Proverbs 29:12 If a ruler hearken to lies, all his servants are wicked.

<u>Deuteronomy 13:1</u> If there arise among you a prophet, or a dreamer of dreams, and giveth thee a sign or a wonder, 2 And the sign or the wonder come to pass, whereof he spake unto thee, saying, Let us go after other gods, which thou hast not known, and let us serve them; 3 Thou shalt not hearken unto the words of that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams: for the LORD your God proveth you, to know whether ye love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul.

<u>Isaiah 29:13</u> Wherefore the Lord said, Forasmuch as this people draw near me with their mouth, and with their lips do honour me, but have removed their heart far from me, and their fear toward me is taught by the precept of men:

(Eze. 33:31)
