Fear is the spiritual opposite of Faith  
Fear is fathered by the devil  
Faith is fathered by God

**1 John 4:18** There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.

**2 Timothy 1:7** For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

**Galatians 5:6** but faith which worketh by love.

**Romans 12:3** but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

**Hebrews 2:14,15** (paraphrased) Christ died to destroy fear of death.

**John 8:44** the devil was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

**All words of fear from the Devil is a lie!**

**Deuteronomy 31:6 & Joshua 1:9** Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for the LORD thy God, he it is that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

**Psalms 34:4** I sought the LORD, and he heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.

**1 Samuel 15:24** And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: for I have transgressed, I feared the people, and obeyed their voice.

**1 Samuel 13:14** the LORD hath sought him a man after his own heart, and the LORD hath commanded him to be captain over his people. **Acts 13:22** I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, he shall fulfil all my will.

**1 Samuel 17:34-37** And David said unto Saul, Thy servant kept his father's sheep, and there came a lion, and a bear, and took a lamb out of the flock: Thy servant slew both the lion and the bear: and this uncircumcised Philistine shall be as one of them.

**Conquer your flesh, represented by a bear. Conquer the devil represented by lion.**

**Then conquer other people's giants**

**1 Samuel 19:18-24** So David fled, and escaped, and came to Samuel to Ramah, and told him all that Saul had done to him. And he and Samuel went and dwelt in Naioth. And it was told Saul, saying, Behold, David is at Naioth in Ramah. Saul prophesied

**Psalms 18:29** For by thee I have run through a troop; and by my God have I leaped over a wall.

**1 Kings 19:2-8** Then Jezebel sent a messenger unto Elijah, saying, so let the gods do to me, and more also, if I make not thy life as the life of one of them by tomorrow about this time. And he arose, and did eat and drink, and went in the strength of that meat forty days and forty nights unto Horeb the mount of God. **Elijah got recharged!**

**2 Kings 6:16,17** And he answered, Fear not: for they that be with us are more than they that be with them. And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the LORD opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha.

**2 Chronicles 20:17** Ye shall not need to fight in this battle: set yourselves, stand ye still, and see the salvation of the LORD with you, O Judah and Jerusalem: fear not, nor be dismayed; tomorrow go out against them: for the LORD will be with you.

**Daniel 3:16-18** Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, answered and said to the king, If it be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver us out of thine hand, O king. But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.

**Jesus fourth man in the fire!**

**Daniel 6:9-11** Wherefore king Darius signed the writing and the decree. Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime. Thrown in lions den, yet lived.

**Luke 10:19** Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

**Mark 4:35-40** Let us pass over unto the other side. And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no faith?
